Our week began in difficult circumstances, when we found that our school minibus wheels had been stolen on Saturday night. While this was a shock and a disappointment, we have been truly touched by the outpouring of kindness and offers of help from our Forestedge families and the local community. Your support reminds us how strong we are when we pull together, thank you.

Our collective worship this week reflected on this event and helped us all think carefully about respect in its many forms. We talked about respecting property, not taking or damaging things that belong to others; respecting people, understanding that our actions affect others; respecting ourselves, choosing to do the right thing, even when no one's watching; and respecting our community, coming together to help when something goes wrong. The children showed real maturity and empathy in these discussions, and it was heart-warming to see how they connected our value of respect to real-life events.

Whilst we are waiting for our new tyres and wheels kindly donated by the community, we are having to hire a minibus at a cost of £500 a week.
